3. Div. IX, Cl. 17-0 through 20-24. 20 Any. Pictorial Shell. \$10, \$6, \$4.

8. Div. IX, Cl. 1-0. Various. Celluloid. Attempt to cover all the subclasses. 5 extra points to anyone who covers all 7 subclasses. In honor of Maureen Loper, our dedicated president. Bay Button Bunch. \$30, \$15, \$5.

16. Div. IX, Cl. 17-0 through 20-24. 25 Any. Similes. No limit on realistic or studio buttons. Choose 5 similes from each of the four pictorial sections. 22. Div. IX, Cl. 20-22.1. 20 Any. Human Transportation. Must mount on world/globe image provided on MBS website. Southwest Button Box. \$20, \$10, \$5.
  
23. Div. IX, Cl. 22-1 + 22-2. 20 Any. Must include one button from the symbols section (22-2). Limited to competitors who have not earned a ribbon in Pattern competition (Section 22). West Michigan Buttoneers. \$15, \$10, \$5.
  
24. Div. IX, Cl. 23-1. 20 M/L, Backgrounds – specialized to 5 screen, 5 twinkles, 5 wood, and 5 free choice. Specialized to metal fronts/tops. Please label and mount by group. In honor of Bill Nelson, who brings us cool buttons to buy. Susan Calkins. \$20, \$10, \$5.
